CLS achieves the following:

ELIGIBLE?

Applicants must qualify under one of the three categories and reside in North America:

- Emerging cooperators (ages 18 35) pursuing a career in or working with cooperatives, credit unions, or mutual insurance
- Individuals new to cooperatives, credit unions, or mutual insurance with less than 5 years of experience
- Post secondary students of any age with an interest in cooperatives, credit unions, or mutual insurance
